RULES AND REGULATIONS

All rules and regulation must be adhered to by all membership types. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the termination of your membership.

CODE OF CONDUCT

PR staff and trustees expects that all users who contribute in whatever way and whatever place or time, or elsewhere on behalf of PR will meet the aims and objectives, ethos and policies of PR. This equally applies to others invited to contribute to PR activities. There is a general responsibility devolving upon all users, to be aware of their own conduct and its effect on others.

- Students are expected at all times to present a high standard of personal integrity and conduct that will not reflect adversely upon the organisation and / or its reputation.
- Students shall behave reasonably and with courtesy towards each other.
- All students are entitled to be heard, providing they are not in conflict with this code.
- All students are entitled to respect from others.
- All students are entitled to be treated with dignity
- All students have a right not to be oppressed
- No student shall be subjected to aggressive behaviour, physical, verbal or emotional.
- No violence, under any circumstance will be acceptable.
- No drugs of any kind will be allowed on premises or at PR events.
- No weapons or offensive objects that can be used to cause harm will be allowed on premises or at PR events.

Failure to comply with the foregoing, and particularly where offence has been caused, will result in action being taken which may, if appropriate, ultimately lead to withdrawal of the usage of PR and finally be excluded.

HOUSE RULES

1. PR and its activities will open to all local residents aged between 8 and 25 years. 5-7 welcome, if accompanied by parents. The age limit for membership will be strictly enforced.
2. No drugs of any kind will be allowed on the premises.
3. No weapons or offensive objects that can be used to cause harm will be allowed on the premises.
4. The rules stating the standard of behaviour expected from users will be clearly displayed on site and enforced.
5. The disciplinary rules for anti-social behaviour, such as swearing, fighting, racial and sexual harassment will be made available to all new members of PR.
6. If any children behave in an unacceptable way, staff will speak to parents, and will then exclude the children if their behaviour does not improve.
7. No smoking will be allowed either on site or during activities outside.
